Aim	The Code Black course is designed to enhance the ability of staff to safely manage situations, where people are threatening you or anyone in your care, until the arrival of security staff or Police.
Descriptor	The WHS Act General Duty of Care requirements is interpreted to mean that employers have both a legal duty and a moral obligation to provide a safe workplace. Employers are responsible implement policies and procedures to prevent aggression or violence from occurring in their workplaces. Code Black is a term used to describe when staff are concerned about their own safety and the safety of others due to abusive or assaultive behaviour or immediate personal threat. This course addresses how to assess the situation, how to handle the situation, demonstrates tactics to help in a situation, highlights and discusses both emergency procedures and control measures.
