

Confined Spaces (RIWHS202D)



Aim	This course is designed to equip individuals with the skill and knowledge to safely enter and work within confined spaces. The requirements of the National Core Training Elements are facilitated in addition to the units of competence issued under The Australian National Training Authority.
Descriptor	This course is designed to ensure the health, safety and welfare of persons who may be required to work in or on confined spaces. In accordance with AS/NZS 2865:2009 Safe Entry and Work in Confined Spaces the program caters for a broad cross section of individuals who by virtue of their workplace role will require training, information and supervision–this course is not industry specific. The context of delivery will target the specific industry sector, audience and their unique workplace hazards to make it realistic and relevant.
