

## Provide First Aid (HLTAID003)



<b>Aim</b>	This course aims to enable participants to confidently manage emergency situations and provide a first aid response to a casualty. It is suitable to both people in workplaces and members of the public who want training in first aid. This course is suitable for those students requiring workplace first aid skills.
<b>Descriptor</b>	This unit of competency describes the skills and knowledge required to provide first aid response, life support, management of casualty(s), the incident and other first aiders, until the arrival of medical or other assistance.
<b>Duration</b>	6-8 hours face to face following completion of written workbook assessment in students own time OR two days face to face training and assessment.

<b>Course Size</b>	10 participants with one trainer. 20 participants with two trainers.
